Information on the Processing of Personal Data (Art. 13 GDPR)



1. Name and contact data of the controller for processing

- for offer creation, order processing, invoicing,
- in order to process any liability claims and assert any claims.

The data processing takes place as a result of your enquiry and is necessary in accordance with Article 6 paragraph 1 sentence 1 lit. b GDPR for the named purpose for the adequate processing of your enquiry and/or for the mutual fulfilment of obligations resulting from a contract.

The personal data that we collect is deleted if it is no longer necessary for the purposes for which it was collected or otherwise processed except if we are obliged to store it for a longer period in accordance with Article 6 paragraph 1 sentence 1 lit. c GDPR because of tax and commercial law storage and documentation obligations or if you have provided consent for storage beyond this period in accordance with Article 6 paragraph 1 sentence 1 lit. a GDPR.

3. Transfer of data to third parties

No transfer of your personal data to third parties will take place for purposes other than those listed in the following. Your personal data will be transferred to third parties insofar as this is necessary for the processing of a contractual relationship with you in accordance with Article 6 paragraph 1 sentence 1 lit. b GDPR.

4. Rights of affected party

You are entitled:

- to withdraw the consent you provided to us at any time in accordance with Article 7 paragraph 3 GDPR. As a result of this we will no longer be able to continue the data processing that was based on this consent;
- to demand information on the personal data on you that we have processed in accordance with Article 15 GDPR. In particular you can demand information on the purpose of the processing, the category of personal data, the categories of recipients to whom the data was or will be disclosed, the planned storage duration, the existence of a right to correction, deletion, limitation or objection, the existence of a right of complaint, the source of your data if we did not collect it and the existence of automated decision including profiling and meaningful information on the details where relevant;
- to demand the immediate rectification or completion of the personal data we are storing in accordance with Article 16 GDPR:
- to demand the erasure of the personal data stored by us in accordance with Article 17 GDPR where the processing is not necessary in order to exercise the right of freedom of expression and information, to fulfil a legal obligation, for reasons of public interest or to establish, exercise or defend legal claims;
- to demand the limitation of the processing of your personal data in accordance with Article 18 GDPR where you are contesting the accuracy of the data or the processing is unlawful but you oppose the erasure of the data and we no longer require the data but you require it for the establishment, exercising or defence of legal claims or you have filed an objection to the processing in accordance with Article 21 GDPR;
- to receive the personal data that you have provided to us in a structured, commonly-used and machine-readable format in accordance with Article 20 GDPR or to demand transfer to another controller and
- to complain to a supervisory authority in accordance with Article 77 GDPR. Normally you can contact the supervisory authority for your habitual place of residence or workplace or of our registered office.

5. Right of objection

Insofar as your data is processed on the basis of legitimate interest in accordance with Article 6 paragraph 1 sentence 1 lit. f GDPR you are entitled, in accordance with Article 21 GDPR, to object to the processing of your personal data where there are reasons for this relating to your particular situation.
